# Fire Pro Shop Fence Defender

— Wood fences make excellent wildfire boundary defenses when they are fire treated and a horizontal ember base is applied at the bottom.

**01**

**Day one** — fire chemistry sprayed on the fence.

**02**

**Day two** — clear or colored penetrating water and UV protection.

**03**

**Ember base** — a horizontal band applied at the bottom, where embers collect.

Wood fences make excellent wildfire boundary defenses when they are fire treated and a horizontal ember base is applied at the bottom. For many of us, **the risk comes from a neighbor who does nothing** to reduce their home's wildfire risk, or our community's.

Fences sprayed with Fire Pro Fence Defender can also be used to close in under decks. Our two-step defense is all about day one: fire chemistry application. Day two is all about our clear or colored penetrating water and UV protection.

Build fences out of cedar, fire treat and stain them, and close in under open decks to block ember attacks.

## Two days. One fence line that fights back.

Day one is the fire chemistry. Day two is the finish that keeps water and UV off it. The same treated boards close in under an open deck.

This fence was fire treated and stained more than eight years ago.



**01** Eight years on, day two's colored penetrating finish is still carrying the water and UV load.



**02** The bottom of the fence is where embers land and pile. A horizontal ember base closes that gap along the whole run.
